

FAQ'S ABOUT RIVERLAND HILLS ADULT CHOIR

1. **Do you have to be a member of the church to sing in the choir?** No.
2. **Do I have to be able to read music?** No. Many who sing in the choir are not great music readers. You will learn a lot as time goes by.
3. **When does the choir rehearse? Is childcare provided?** The choir rehearses each Wednesday at 7:00 pm in the choir room on the upper level just outside the church office. Childcare thru grade 8 is provided for rehearsals and services.
4. **How do I know what part to sing?** Talk with Stuart. He will help you find a comfortable spot for your particular voice and abilities.
5. **How do I join?** Simply attend two rehearsals.
6. **Can I bring a visitor to choir rehearsal?** Whether a prospect or just a friend or family member, visiting guests are always welcome in rehearsal.
7. **Is there an assigned seating order?** No one has an assigned or "promised" seat on a weekly basis. Often, for special productions a seating chart with assigned seats is used.
8. **Can I take my music home to practice?** Yes, but you must bring it back for the next service or rehearsal.
9. **When will I get an assigned folder and robe?** After your 2nd rehearsal.
10. **Does the choir sing every Sunday?** Yes. We sing for the 9:00 and 10:15 services every Sunday. We also sing for other special events including revivals, annual meeting, mission efforts and special seasonal concerts.
11. **If we sing both services, how can I be in bible fellowship(Sunday School)?** In both services, the choir leaves the loft after singing, allowing us to go to bible fellowship during one service and remain for worship in the other.
12. **If I miss Wednesday rehearsal, should I sing on Sunday?** Most definitely! We rehearse music 6-10 weeks ahead, so missing one rehearsal won't prevent you from singing that piece you've been working on for awhile. **Conversely**, if you know you will miss a Sunday, we ask that you attend the Wednesday rehearsal immediately prior as we'll be working on music for upcoming Sundays.
