9:30 AM | THE ATTIC

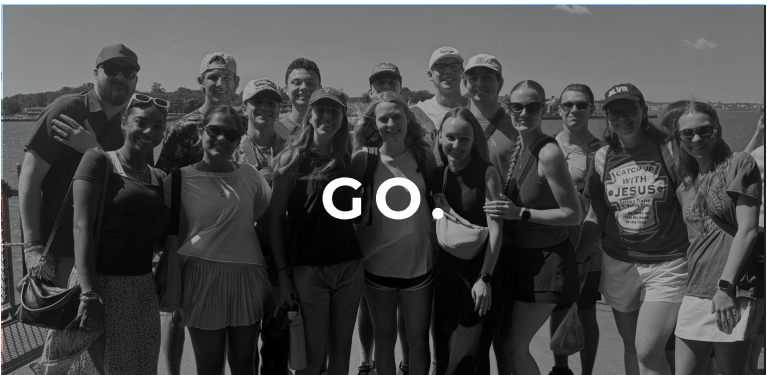
During our 9:30 Student Hour in the Attic, students will hear Biblical teaching on key topics like Prayer, Evangelism, Apologetics, etc. After 30 minutes of group-wide teaching, our leaders will lead students in a designated "Talk Time" where students will discuss application questions from our teaching time. The goal of talk time is to apply God's Word to real life through real conversation. We will close our time with 10 minutes of prayer before students leave the Attic at 10:45am. This hour will be taught by various student ministry leaders that are committed to faithfully teaching God's Word.

PASSAGE TRIP **APRIL 17 – 19, 2026**

This retreat at Camp Longridge is designed for parents and their 5th graders, as they prepare for middle school! Parenting is one of life's greatest joys, but it's also incredibly challenging. Parents often find themselves discouraged, isolated and silent about the real issues they are facing at home. Our heart is to encourage and equip 5th grade parents as they prepare for their child's middle school years & beyond!

This retreat is designed to be a rite of passage retreat between parents and children! Our prayer is that you would use this weekend to strengthen heart connections with your child, be encouraged through sessions with other parents, make lasting memories, share stories, formulate a practical discipleship plan, get to know our student team, and have fun as a family at Camp Longridge!





2025 FALL RETREATS **MIDDLE SCHOOL: OCT 3 – 5** **HIGH SCHOOL: OCT 17 – 19**

Every October we take our middle and high school students on separate weekend trips to Look Up Lodge or Camp McCall. Students have countless opportunities for outdoor camp fun in the cool mountain air! Each retreat includes a weekend theme with gospel-centered Bible teaching sessions and sharing time around the fire. Fall Retreat is an intentionally slower pace than our other student retreats.





DNOW **MARCH 6 – 8, 2026**

We kick off spring with our “Disciple Now” weekend that you don’t want to miss! Students join us at the church for a weekend of intensive discipleship that includes preaching from a guest speaker with a yearly theme, worship, off-campus fun, group competitions, meals, and sermon discussions led by our discipleship leaders! We have about 30 college and young adult leaders who disciple students and lead a group. Students stay overnight in host homes with their grade and gender-specific small group.





2026 BEACH BLAST **MIDDLE SCHOOL: JULY 5 – 8** **HIGH SCHOOL: JULY 8 – 12**

Beach Blast is hands down the highlight of our year! We pack up our entire church and plant it right next to the Beach at Garden City Retreat Center. Our pastors, worship team, adult leaders, and discipleship leaders all join us for an incredible week of focusing on what matters most: our relationship with Jesus! Our sermons and small group discussions all center around our yearly theme. Our “talk times” give leaders and students time to process the truth they have heard, ask questions, and apply God’s Word to real life through real conversation. We spend time sharing stories of how God is at work and praying for one another. There are countless options for fun during free time between the beach, the pool, the pier, the arcade, ice-cream shops, volleyball, basketball, pickleball, and off-campus activities like go-karts, the waterpark, and Broadway at the Beach!





SUMMER WITH RH STUDENTS

Summertime in our student ministry presents some unique discipleship opportunities like serving at VBS, being disciplined and challenged at Beach Blast, and serving on a short-term mission team! During the summer, we meet on Wednesday nights for "Summer Nights" (6-8pm) instead of "The Gathering" which takes place on Sunday nights throughout the school year.
